Dear Insurance Representative,

I am writing to provide documentation of the current condition of my roof in relation to the renewal of my homeowner's insurance policy referenced above.

Attached to this letter, you will find a Remaining Useful Life (RUL) certification performed by a licensed authorized inspector confirming that my roof has at least 5 years of remaining useful life. This inspection was conducted in accordance with the requirements of Florida Statute 627.7011.

As you are aware, under Florida law (Senate Bill 2D, effective July 1, 2022), an insurer may not refuse to issue or renew a homeowner's insurance policy solely because of the age of the roof if an inspection performed by an authorized inspector indicates the roof has 5 or more years of remaining useful life.

Additionally, my roof has been professionally treated with Peak 301 — an all-natural, soy-based roof rejuvenation sealant that restores shingle flexibility and waterproofing. The attached Peak 301 Treatment Certificate documents this treatment, including warranty

terms and treatment date.

Based on the attached certification and treatment documentation, I respectfully request that my policy be renewed with Replacement Cost Value (RCV) coverage terms.
